WHAT TO BRING TO ST. MARGARET'S

As you begin to think about packing, please remember that you will be sharing space with a roommate, and your room and closet may be smaller than what you are used to at home. We will furnish a standard twin bed, desk, chair, and dresser.

Beyond these things, we ask that you bring:

- Computer (required)

- Pillow(s), twin sheets, comforter, and/or blanket
- Bath towels
- Laundry basket or bag
- Laundry detergent
- Shower caddy with accessories (toothbrush, shampoo, soap, etc.)
- Desk lamp, bed lamp, and light bulbs
- Alarm clock
- Hangers
- Surge protectors
- Flashlight with batteries
- Stacking storage units for desk
- Backpack
- River shoes (required)

Optional items include:

- iPod station and/or speaker
- Lap desk
- Ethernet cord
- Pencil sharpener
- Sleeping bag
- Key chain/ring
- Beach towel
- Hair dryer/straightener
- Posters
- Rug
- Cell phone

*We strongly recommend that all students bring a small lock box (safe) that locks with a key or combination. Please put your daughter's name on the box and make sure she knows how to open it.

Below is a list of items that you should *not* bring:

- Curtains

- Toaster oven, coffee pot, hot plates, sun lamp, popcorn popper, or microwave
- Televisions
- Refrigerators (*except seniors, prefects, and desk aides*)
- Candles or other flammables
- Glass containers

- Anything irreplaceable

WHAT TO BRING TO ST. MARGARET'S WARDROBE CONSIDERATIONS

The weather in Tappahannock is mild but seasonal. We experience both warm and humid weather as well as cold spells with snow. Students should bring clothing suitable for a variety of temperatures.

Students' clothes should always be neat, clean, and appropriate for the occasion. We do not allow torn, fringed, wrinkled, or revealing clothing of any kind to be worn.

Acceptable Dress for the Academic Day:

- All students are required to wear items included in the St. Margaret's School wardrobe purchased from Flynn & O'Hara: www.flynnohara.com
- For field trips, church, and other special occasions, students are required to wear specific pieces from the school wardrobe which make up the school uniform.
 - These pieces include: plaid skirt of appropriate length; navy vest or sweater; white button down shirt (short or long sleeve); black, flat, closed toe and closed heel leather shoes; and black footed tights (optional).

Acceptable Non-Academic Dress:

- Pants and jeans
- Sweatshirts and sweatpants
- Shorts of appropriate length
- T-shirts without writing, messages, drawings, pictures or without any other material deemed inappropriate by an adult
- Sleeveless shirts with shoulder straps at least one inch wide
- Sneakers and sandals (no flip flops)

Be sure to also bring:

- Winter coat
- Swimsuit and cover up
